Club Descriptions

Sport Club: Children will enjoy being involved in soccer games that build strength, perfect simple motor skills, improve hand/eye coordination, and encourage social interactions. Soccer games will help children grow such key skills as running, jumping, turning, kicking, and balancing.

Music and Creative Movement: In this class, students will sing, listen, move, and play musical instruments. They will develop balance, control, and coordination through activities that are fun and challenging; explore abstract concepts at an experimental level; develop self-awareness; emphasize give-and-take social interactions through play and creative movement; express activities and feelings of everyday life; tell a story through movement; and find out how parts of the body feel while moving to the music.

Art Studio: In this literacy-based club, children will explore collections of art from around the world: Africa, Japan, Australia, Europe, North and South America, and create projects inspired by them.

The club will give students an environment in which they will express their feelings through art, practice problem solving, build self-confidence, and improve fine motor and communication skills.

Book Club: Besides building a love for reading, the Book Club will develop an abundance of literacy skills: the ability to use comprehension strategies; to compare and contrast authors, themes, concepts and ideas; the ability to understand how reading teaches about the world; and plant a seed for being a good writer. After reading and discussing a book, children will continue building relationships and engage in book-related games, arts and crafts, or act the books out.

Open Play and Morning Playgroup: Children play in classroom centers or at our playground.

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
